1. The uniformity in releasing the benefits in favour of the petitioners towards the admissible HRA is an issue which is sought to be canvassed.
2. The factual matrix in these petitions, which are clubbed together, reflects that the respondents have discriminately applied the same policy.
3. The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioners are that the present issue is covered by the judgement dated 21st May, 2026, rendered by the Hon'ble Division Bench in W.P.(C) 8154/2024 and other connected matters, which is produced at Annexure P-18 in W.P.(C) 11794/2026.
4. Issue notice to the respondents.
5. Mr. Satyam Pahal, SPC, waives notice on behalf of the respondents.
6. Let the response be placed on record within a period of four weeks from today.
7. Re-notify on 15th October, 2026.
8. In the meantime, impugned order dated 1st August, 2026 be not given effect to.
